Sage 300 Product Update 1 program fixes

System Manager

Fixed a problem in the System Manager related to slow performance when importing users, importing user authorization, and modifying user authorization. (Reference #8009775742)

Order Entry

Fixed a problem which triggered an access violation message when drilling down in Order Entry (desktop only). (Reference #8009704029, #8009521030, #8009536393, #8009558542, #8009545018, #8009621111, #8009765699)

Intercompany Transactions

Fixed a problem that prevented the user from processing the Update Company function. (Reference #8009773509)

Sage CRM

Fixed a problem where the statistics year or period for promoted customers was read-only. (Reference #8009723584)

Sage 300 2025 program fixes

Sage 3002025 includes program fixes for some problems that exist in the most recent previous version (Sage 300 2023 Product Update 3). The following sections describe these program fixes.

Web API

Fixed an issue where the Web API endpoint for IC Item Location Details was not available. (Reference # SM01_2648820230508)

System Manager

Fixed a problem that prevents import in web screens when the IIS server is configured with a proxy site. (Reference # 8009627198)

Bank Services

Fixed a problem on the withdrawal amount when reversing an entry (Reference # 8009658363)

Accounts Payable

Fixed a problem in which the number of decimals in VB screen (desktop) and number of decimals in web screens were not consistent in GL entry. (Reference 8009480228)

Fixed a problem that prevented saving a GL Financial Report. (Reference # 8007288528)

Order Entry

Fixed a problem on UK Tax (TK70) VAT Return Entry Form where the Source Currency is used instead of Home Currency (Reference # 8009653339) (Reference # 8009653663)

General Information

- Sage 300 2025 supports upgrades *only* from version 5.6 or later.
- If you use workstation setup, you must also run Sage 300 Intelligence Reporting workstation setup (located in BX80A\WSSetup) on every workstation where you will view and use Intelligence Reporting screens.
- You require version 2025 (internally versioned as 7.2A) of all core programs that you plan to use.

If you use Canadian Payroll or US Payroll, you require version 8.0 of these programs with the most current tax updates.

Note: The tax tables for version 7.3 were available until March 2024. After this date tax tables and support will only be available for Payroll version 8.0.

Important! You must install Sage 300 before installing payroll programs.

- If you are upgrading from an earlier version, you must upgrade all Sage 300 programs to 2025 at the same time. Sage 3002025 programs do not work with programs from earlier versions.

- If you have a subscription license, you don't need to enter serial numbers and activation keys for individual Sage 300 applications. When the License Manager appears during installation, the only license information you need to enter is your Client ID, Company Name, and Serial Number. After you've entered this information, ensure that you have internet access, and then click Refresh to verify your subscription.
- If you do not have the following programs, which are required to use Sage 300, they are installed with Sage 300:
 - MSXML (Microsoft XML Core Services) 6.0
 - Microsoft SQL Server Native Client 12.0
 - Microsoft .NET Framework 4.8.2
- Sage 300 2025 includes SP34 for SAP Crystal Reports® runtime engine. If you use Sage HRMS or Sage Fixed Assets integrated with Sage 300, refer to the Sage 300 2025 Compatibility Guide for updated information on compatibility with Sage HRMS and Sage Fixed Assets. The Sage 300 2025 Compatibility Guide is available from Sage Knowledgebase article [26777](#).

Compatibility with other programs

Known issues

- When using the Notes screen on the Sage 300 classic desktop:
 - When adding or editing a note, the text editing area and toolbar appear only if you have enabled active scripting and scripting of Java applets in Internet Explorer security settings. For more information, see Sage Knowledgebase article [76898](#).
 - The Notes screen does not appear correctly if you use the Medium - 125% display size (specified in Windows control panel). For more information, see Sage Knowledgebase article [76926](#).
- When previewing reports in web screens, information in some reports is not aligned correctly. To work around this issue, export the report to PDF format. For more information, see Sage Knowledgebase article [76337](#).
- In some fields, Chinese language characters cannot be entered.
- Printing issue with Sage Fixed Assets Integration (FAS). Report printing in both FAS and Sage 300 will not work after the installation of FAS Integration. To work around this issue, you need to restore a Crystal runtime dll. For more information, see Sage Knowledgebase article [230907204735260](#).

Installing product updates

After installing a product update:

- If you use Sage 300cloud web screens, you must use Database Setup to configure the Portal database again.
- If you use Sage CRM integrated with Sage 300, you must upgrade your CRM integration as follows:
 - Install the Sage CRM integration for Sage 300, which is available on Sage Knowledgebase article [45434](#).
 - Uninstall and then reinstall the Sage CRM Synchronization Component. (Use the Sage CRM Workstation Setup screen in Sage 300 to install the Sage CRM Synchronization Component.)
- You should clear your browser's cache. (Some fixes included in the update may not take effect until you do.)
- On any workstations you use, you must reinstall workstation setup as the Windows administrator user if:
 - The product update includes changes to workstation setup.
 - An earlier product update includes changes to workstation setup, and you have not previously installed that product update or any other subsequent product update.

Example: Suppose that the current Product Update is 4. Product Update 2 includes changes to workstation setup, and the other product updates do not. You have been using Product Update 1. You did not install Product Update 2, or 3. You have now installed Product Update 4. To update your workstations with the changes to workstation setup that were included in Product Update 2, you must reinstall workstation setup.

Removing Sage 300

Before removing Sage 300, you must:

- Close all instances of the Sage 300 Desktop.
- Close all applications that integrate with Sage 300.

- Stop all Sage 300 services that are running, such as Sage 300 .CNA.Windows Service.

To remove Sage 300 2025 programs:

1. In Windows' Control Panel, click Programs And Features.
2. Open Uninstall Or Change A Program, and then:
 - To remove all Sage 300 programs, double-click Sage 300 2025.
 - To remove individual Sage 300 programs:
 - a. Click Sage 300 2025, and then click Change. (Do not double-click Sage 300 2025.)
 - b. Click Modify, and then use the Select Features screen to select the programs you want to install and clear the selections for programs you want to remove.

Migration from VB6 to .NET

The core of the application has been migrated from VB6 to the modern .NET framework.

The .NET framework is designed to provide users with the following improved stability, security, and performance features:

- It ensures better compatibility with current operating systems and facilitates integration with advanced technologies.
- It enables more frequent updates, a more responsive user interface, and enhanced security features to better protect user data.
- It aims to significantly enhance productivity and lays the foundation for introducing new features and capabilities in future releases.

Office 365 Support for Email Distribution

Support for Office 365 has been added to the Excel distribution module, enabling users to utilize Office 365 for email distribution. This enhancement ensures compatibility with modern email systems, providing users with a more reliable and efficient email distribution method.

Add SMTP TLS 1.2 Support

Support for TLS1.2 has been added to the SMTP module in the Excel distribution, ensuring secure email transmissions.

This enhancement provides users with an additional layer of security when sending emails.

New Excel 2013+ Connection Type

Support for Excel 2013+ workbooks has been added to the Connector, allowing an Excel 2013+ workbook to be used as a data source in the Connector module. Previously, only the XLS file type was supported. Now, all XLSX file types are supported, enhancing compatibility and providing users with greater flexibility in their data sources.

This update ensures seamless integration with modern Excel formats, improving overall efficiency in data handling.

Replace SQL CE with VistaDB

The Universal Query Engine now utilizes VistaDB instead of SQL CE, resulting in improved database performance and reliability. This update ensures that database operations are more efficient and robust, enhancing the overall stability of the application.

Performance Enhancements

Various performance improvements have been implemented, including faster report execution times and more efficient product navigation.

These enhancements are designed to provide users with a more responsive and efficient application, improving overall productivity.

Furthermore, a new lite version of the Financial Ratios report has been included. This report runs out significantly faster than the standard report.

UI/UX Updates and Enhancements

A range of UI and UX updates have been made, including new icons and a native Windows look and feel.

These changes aim to improve the user experience by making the interface more intuitive and visually appealing.

Additional updates:

- The mouse wheel can now be used to scroll the properties pane.
- Various improvements to avoid text being cut off when scaling is applied.
- Sage Intelligence Excel ribbon now labeled SI Tools.

Navigation Explorer Updates

Improvements have been made to the navigation explorer to provide a more intuitive and efficient navigation experience.

These updates ensure that users can quickly and easily find the reports and tools they need.

Additional updates:

- Renaming reports now reflects immediately in the navigation pane.
- Toggle Show/Hide reports now reflects immediately in the navigation pane.

Branding Updates

The application has been updated to match the new Sage branding, ensuring a consistent and professional appearance.

These branding updates apply to all standard reports, maintaining a cohesive look across the application.

Add XLSX Support

Support for XLSX, XLSB, XLTX, and XLSM file formats has been added in various places, providing users with greater flexibility in handling different Excel file formats.

This update ensures compatibility with a wide range of Excel files, enhancing the application's versatility.

Side by Side Support

The new version can now be installed side by side with the previous version, allowing users to transition smoothly without disrupting their workflow.

This feature ensures that users can test the new version while still having access to the previous one.

Security Enhancements

Various security enhancements have been implemented to ensure the application remains secure and robust against potential threats. With the migration to the .NET framework, users benefit from the enhanced security features that .NET offers, including improved authentication and encryption protocols.

The integration with Office 365 for email distribution leverages its built-in security measures, ensuring that email communications are protected by advanced threat detection and data loss prevention technologies.

Additionally, new, more robust, encryption technologies have been used when handling any potentially sensitive data.

Known issues

- If you have multiple versions of Microsoft Excel installed, you may need to manually load the Report Designer Task Pane Excel Add-in.
- If you use exclusions in account and row set rules, exclusion accounts may appear when you drill down to balance.
- If Sage 300 Intelligence Reporting was installed by a user other than you (for example, an administrator), you must open Microsoft Excel before running reports in Report Viewer or Report Manager.
- In Report Viewer, an "Open File - Security Warning" message appears for every report you view. (This message should only appear once, when you first open Report Viewer.)
- If you use Microsoft Excel 2013, and you save a report template in Report Manager using Save Excel Template:
 - When you run the report in Excel, an "External Data" message may appear. You can proceed by clicking Yes.
 - If the report template has a timeline, the timeline does not retain its filters.
